Young Minds: Treating Depression & Anxiety in Young People
Introductory Module

The Australian General Practice Network (AGPN), and *beyondblue: the national depression initiative*, have formed a partnership to develop the **Young Minds** training program. **Young Minds** is a prevention and early intervention program for GPs, practice nurses and allied health professionals focusing on skills development in the diagnosis, management and treatment of high prevalence mental health disorders occurring in young people.

Young Minds is a GPMHSC accredited **Mental Health Skills Training** package and approved and endorsed by: the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (6 hour Active Learning Module, completion earns 40 CPD points); the Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (completion earns 6 ACRRM PDP); the Australian Association of Social Workers (2 points per learning hour); and, the Royal College of Nursing Australia (attracting 6 Continuing Nurse Education points).
